Treasurer’s Report and Authorization to Pay Bills – General checking: \$48,727.70; General savings: \$746,626.13; Online Bill Pay: \$16.08; Sewer Checking: \$27,232.11; Sewer Construction Checking: \$5.00; Sewer Debt Retirement: \$289,405.23; USDA Restricted RRI: \$97,396.25; Sewer CD Savings: \$742,814.94; Sewer Savings: \$493,827.04; Curtiss reviewed the monthly bills. Streng made a motion to approve the treasurer’s report and to authorize the payment of the monthly bills; Support – Schafer; motion passed.

9. Board Reports

A. Fire Department Report – Next regular meeting is Wednesday, July 9, 2025.

B. Council of Governments/Isabella MTA meeting – Last month’s meeting was hosted by Coe Township, and the Isabella County Prosecutor’s Office did a presentation on the services they provide.

C. Treasurer’s Report – Summer tax bills were mailed at the end of June.

D. Clerk’s Report – The yearly audit for the township starts next week. The township received the May/June State Revenue Sharing check in the amount of \$38,741.90. Election reimbursement claims were mailed to the three school districts who held May school elections.

10. Old Business

A. Beal City/Coldwater Lake Sewer Project – Beal City – The school is connecting the new classrooms on the east end of the school, as well as the football field locker room they are building, to the BC sewer system. Coldwater Lake – The project went to bid in early June and bids will be opened on Wednesday, July 9th at 11:00 a.m. at the hall.

B. Weidman Sewer Project – Nothing to report.

A. Special Assessment Resolution No. 1 – Curtiss read the resolution and made a motion to approve the resolution; support – Galinski; Mindel did a roll call vote; 4 yes and 1 no; resolution approved.

B. Power Outlets on Light Poles – Galinski made a motion to approve an agreement with Consumers to put power outlets on 14 light poles on Beal City Road, using Block Electric as the contractor; support – Streng; motion approved. Streng made a motion to contribute up to half of the cost of the project, not to exceed \$2,800.00 (Beal City Business Association to pay the rest); support – Schafer; motion approved.

C. New Computer at Lift Station – Streng made a motion to approve the purchase of a new computer for the Beal City lift station; support – Galinski; motion approved.

12. Adjournment – Curtiss made a motion to adjourn; Support – Schafer, meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
